1 **SEC. ____ . OCCOQUAN RIVER, VIRGINIA.**

2 (a) **PROJECT MODIFICATION.**—The project for navi-
3 gation, Occoquan Creek, Virginia, authorized by the first
4 section of the Act entitled “An Act making appropriations
5 for the construction, repair, and preservation of certain
6 public works on rivers and harbors, and for other pur-
7 poses”, approved September 19, 1890 (26 Stat. 440), is
8 modified to direct the Secretary of the Army—

9 (1) to deepen the project to a depth of 9 feet;

10 and

11 (2) to widen the project between Channel Mark-
12 er Number 2 and the bridge at United States Route
13 1 to a width of 200 feet.

14 (b) **AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.**—Amounts appro-
15 priated to carry out the project referred to in subsection
16 (a) by the Energy and Water Development Appropriations
17 Act, 2001 (as enacted into law by Public Law 106–377),
18 shall be made available to carry out the modifications to
19 the project under subsection (a).

20 (c) **PROJECT REDESIGNATION.**—

21 (1) **IN GENERAL.**—The project referred to in
22 subsection (a) shall be known and designated as the
23 “project for navigation, Occoquan River, Virginia”.

1 (2) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law,
2 map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of
3 the United States to the project referred to in sub-
4 section (a) shall be deemed to be a reference to the
5 “project for navigation, Occoquan River, Virginia”.
